Thoughts about Parashat T'zaveh and "tainted money"

"Jews must not...lie to a Jew or non-Jew, and not mislead anyone in any matter....For if Jews cheat non-Jews, they will say, 'Look how God chose for His people a nation of thieves and deceivers.'" Rabbi Joseph Telushkin citing Rabbi Moshe of Concy.

"Stealing from a non-Jew is worse than stealing from a Jew because of the profanation of God's name." Rabbi Telushkin quoting Tosefta Bava Kamma.

"It is forbidden to fulfill a commandment through a transgression." Rabbi Telushkin citing from the Babylonian Talmud (Sukkah).

**Lunch and Learn Seminar Sunday, March 7, 12:30 pm**

**The Lord of Hosts: Yahweh as a War God**

**Dr. Jonathan Roth**, Professor of History, San Jose State University Dr. Roth will discuss the Biblical term "Lord of Hosts", which comes from the Hebrew term "Yahweh Tzaba'ot". In early books of the Bible, God often functions as a general, directing the Children of Israel in wars. After the fall of the kingdoms of Israel and Judah, Jews frequently served in the armies of surrounding nations. Worship of the "Lord of Hosts" might have played an important role in the survival of Judaism in exile. Dr. Roth will show how war played a much larger role in early Judaism than is often recognized.
