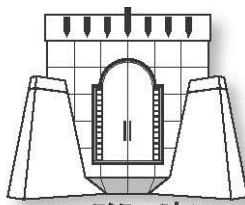

Should this be impossible, the ḥametz may be stored in such a way that we are sure not to use it during the holiday and its actual ownership transferred to a non-Jew until after the holiday ends. 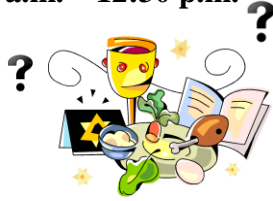
