1. (7:11—21) The *Sh'lamim*: the peace or thanks-offering. There are three kinds: of thanksgiving, in fulfillment of a vow, and as a free-will offering.
2. (7:22—27) One is not allowed to eat *heilev*, the fat that covers the internal organs of the animal, because it was consecrated to be offered on the altar. Blood is also prohibited.
3. (7:28—38) The portions of the *sh'lamim* that go to the priests.

Siyum Bechorim Fast of First Born

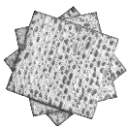
Friday, March 30, 2018 7:00 - 9:00 a.m.
