

DONOR RECOGNITION POLICY

Adopted: February 12, 2020

The provisions of confidentiality in any Financial Policy notwithstanding, Congregation Beth David may publicly recognize donors and gifts or donations made to the synagogue, without revealing the specific amount donated, provided the donor has not invoked the anonymity provisions of the Gift Acceptance Policy as part of their gift.

The Board of Directors, upon the recommendation of the Finance and Budget Committee, may establish donor recognition levels and criteria for various campaigns and/or time periods. The Finance and Budget Committee shall be informed of those persons or families who have met the required levels and criteria for recognition, and may provide the information as appropriate to ensure donors are properly recognized.

FY 19-20 Donor Recognition

Members whose total contributions to Congregation Beth David during the FY19-20 Fiscal Year meet or exceed the sustaining contribution number for their membership class shall be recognized as Sustainers of the congregation. Members whose total contributions exceed the sustaining contribution by \$750 per adult member (\$750 for individual adult households, \$1500 for two-adult households) shall be recognized as Major Donors to Congregation Beth David.
