# IDEAS BROUGHT UP AT THE MEETING

#### I. Red Balloon Initiative

A local Israeli presented this idea which is being done around the world (see photos in link below). If the board approves the idea, we'll have a signup sheet for the different items. One suggestion made that for the sake of the environment perhaps not to use 222 helium balloons but a subset along with the 222 posters as in some of the photos which used placards for 10-20 posters per balloon. And of course to be very careful that the balloons don't get released.

Description: The Red Balloon Initiative is a global display aimed at raising awareness about the Israeli hostages held in Gaza by Hamas. (Pictures and videos on Instagram at https://instagram.com/theredballoon2023?igshid=MzRIODBiNWFIZA==)

This initiative involves setting up a powerful exhibition in central locations like City Halls, where there's heavy foot traffic. The display comprises 222 red balloons, each one attached to a poster representing one of the kidnapped citizens and attached to a pair of shoes. For children, the red balloons and posters can be affixed to strollers, and for the elderly, they can be attached to walkers or wheelchairs. This visually impactful demonstration serves as a moving reminder of the individuals affected by this situation, making a compelling statement in support of the hostages' cause.

Another initiative is the <u>"Empty Table"</u>, that could be done in a parking lot or park.

2. Compassion Works tourniquets - Gene Tenberg <u>www.compressionworks.com</u>

This company supplies specialized tourniquets with a pump, enabling it to control massive bleeding for a long period of time until the injured soldier can be taken to the hospital.

- a. THe first hurdle is figuring out how to get them to the IDF. Gene has attempted to figure this out through FIDF and the Embassy but to no avail. So he's looking for anyone who might have contacts within the IDF related to distribution logistics.
- b. Next is to get donations so that enough systems can be manufactured and sent to where it's needed.

### 3. Work towards showing restraint in Gaza

This discussion was tabled at this point. Obviously no one wants to see the extreme loss of life happening to the Palestinians. But at this moment in time let's stay united and focus on what we can do right now. Focusing on keeping the spotlight on freeing the hostages, assisting the IDF in defending Israel (their job), and supporting displaced, traumatized Israelis.
